



## **Documents to provide to apply for FIH Membership**

According to FIH Statutes articles 2.2 (b) iii & viii, 2.3 (c), 2.4 (b) & (d), 4.1 (c) and 4.2 and summarize below in a few points:

1. The Constitution or Statutes of the National Association which must follow the template provided by FIH;
2. The names, addresses and gender of its officers;
3. Basic set up in terms of number of clubs, number of members and players;
4. An attestation, endorsement and confirmation by its NOC or Sports Ministry (or equivalent, the highest national authority in sport in that country) that the NA is the body solely responsible for governing hockey for men and women in that country;
5. A declaration that it has applied for membership of its CF;
6. A financial document (audited annual accounts) indicating that the NA is solvent.

New applicant should be able to show, before their membership is approved by Congress that they have in place the 2 sets of Regulations required by the FIH namely:

1. Sanctioned and Unsanctioned Events
2. Anti-Corruption
